

Job Title: Greenskeeper
Department: Golf Course Maintenance
Reports to: Golf Course Superintendent
Job Group: Non-Exempt

Position Summary: Performs the diverse range of activities involved in golf course maintenance, mainly ground construction and maintenance work.

Essential Job Functions:

- Mow greens, tees, collars, approaches to greens and fairways with a walking and/or driving mower.
- Mow lake banks, trap edges and other areas with fly mowers.
- Gather debris which includes limbs, leaves, small sticks, etc.
- Change cups/tee markers.
- Top-dress greens and tees.

Other Duties & Responsibilities:

- Edge cart paths
- Trap raking (hand and mechanized).
- Cart path edging.
- Repair ball marks on greens and tee and fairway divots.
- Excavate trenches for irrigation, drainage, root pruning, etc.
- Clean shop according to the designated schedule.
- Mechanical removal of weeds.
- Remove and lay sod.
- Maintain and operate all equipment in a safe efficient manner.
- Clean, wax, and hand dry all equipment after use.
- Check fuel and oil levels before leaving the shop.
- Exercise proper etiquette around members and guests on the golf course.
- Operate heavy equipment.
- May perform other assignments and duties, as area needs require.

Skills & Knowledge:

- Ability to understand and interpret directions and company policies and procedures.
- Load or transport 50 lbs. and mow per standard operating procedures.
- Prior experience not required.
- Playing knowledge of the game preferred but not required.

Licensure/Certification:

- None

Special Working Conditions:

- Work is primarily performed in an outside environment and involves moving materials up to 50 lbs, exposures to chemicals and pesticides, excessive noise levels, fumes, grease & oil, dust, extreme heat and humidity, flying golf balls, and various machinery and equipment.
- Work schedule may include overtime, holidays and weekends.
